# Information for visitors playing against BRFC at our home venues

Your club may have already shared information on Covid19, however, please review the rules specific to our venues when playing Bedwell Rangers FC

#### At the venue

Please follow any guidance such as one way systems that the venue has put in place. The club may have supplied this before the match.

#### Watching the game

We ask that where possible a maximum of one parent is asked to stay. If there is an accident, we ask parents to administer support in the first instance. Naturally if it is an emergency, our coaches will apply first aid, using the PPE supplied.

## **Social Distancing**

Supporters, parents, and other spectators **should remain socially distanced** whilst attending events. Spectator groups must be restricted to discrete six-person gathering limits and spread out, in line with wider Government guidance, ensuring space for officials, coaches and substitutes

#### Track & Trace

It is now mandatory for all clubs to track and trace. You will be asked by one of our volunteers to supply information or use the track and trace app. This information is kept for 21 days then securely destroyed. Please ensure your details are given when requested.

## **General Visitor information**

We would also like to remind you of a number of general rules at our venues, in particular, at school grounds.

- Absolutely No Smoking or Vaping in the school grounds. If visitors wish to smoke, they must leave the school grounds completely.
- Please take all litter away
- No dogs allowed on school grounds
